## Stamps

Cookie-Cutter Christmas
Teeny Tiny Wishes

## Measurements

Old Olive CS: $75 / 8 \times 2$ 1/8"
Whisper White CS: 2 1/2 x 8 1/2"

## Supplies

Memento Tuxedo Black Pad
Old Olive Dark, Pumpkin Pie Dark and Ivory Stampin' Blends, Basic Gray Stampin' Write Marker

## Tools

Stitched Shapes Framelits Dies
Cookie Cutter Builder Punch
Simply Scored Scoring Tool
Big Shot
Bone Folder
Stapler

## Embellishments

Wink of Stella Glitter Brush Gold (retired)

## Adhesives

Multi-Purpose Liquid Glue
Stampin' Dimensionals

## Matchbook Treat Holder <br> A Step-by-Step Tutorial

1. Stamp the Santa image twice on the Whisper White cardstock using the Memento pad.
2. With the Stampin' Blends and Markers, color one Santa completely, and the belt only on the second.
3. Punch the two Leprechauns and crop an oval using the third largest oval from the Stitched Shapes Framelits.
4. With Paper Snips, crop the belt and head from the second Leprechaun.
5. Hand snip the sides off the round head to create a Leprechaun hat. Flip to unstamped side and color with Old Olive Stampin' Blend.
6. Adhere the hat using Multi-Purpose Glue. Add the second belt to the hat. With Stampin' Dimensionals, adhere Leprechaun to the Whisper White oval. Set aside.
7. Place the Old Olive cardstock on the Scoring Tool with the long side abutted to the top. Score at $31 / 4, " 31 / 2, "$ and 7 ". Use the bone folder to crease and create the matchbook.
8. Stamp the sentiment using the Memento pad centered horizontally and vertically on the $5 / 8$ fold at the top of the Old Olive cardstock.
9. Insert the treat inside the matchbook and staple. Adhere the oval image to the front of the matchbook using Multi-Purpose Glue. You're done!
